Winemaker Notes

Richly aromatic Pinot Noir with a fragrant character, rich fruit and a firm, structured style.

Vineyard

Boucherottes vineyard is located in the south of Beaune, up against the border with Pommard.

Winemaking

Grapes are vinified in open vats for around 4 weeks, which brings out all the expressions of the terroir.

Vintage

Conditions for 2014 started well before a violent hailstorm in June hit several communes in the Mâcon and Côte d'Or with devastating effects. Summer then continued to be unsettled but a period of dry weather in September returned the available grapes to good health and the grapes were harvested from 11th September onwards.
