Winemaker Notes

This wine shows excellent depth and character. Some of the 1er Cru elements of the vineyard are included in the blend making it a great buy. Full-bodied and firm, with finesse.

Vineyard

The 'Clos de la Croix de Pierre' is situated next to the premier cru 'En Caradeux'. It is south facing no far from the village of Pernand. The soil is mainly limestone with little rocks on the surface. It gets its name from a large cross situation next to the climat.

Winemaking

This wine shows excellent depth and character. Some of the 1er Cru elements of the vineyard are included in the blend making it a great buy. Full-bodied and firm, with finesse.

Vintage

A vintage of excellent quality, which started early thanks to a warm spring and early summer, with some very hot weather in July and August. Pinot Noir in particular had small berries, but beautifully concentrated and Chardonnay managed to hold its acidity.
